

Preparing for your Puppy

1. FEEDING YOUR PUPPY

Your puppy is eating Science Diet Large Breed Puppy (chicken meal & barley). We recommend you feed this type of puppy food until one year of age.

Feed your puppy _____ cups _____ times a day. Also, offer them plenty of fresh water.

2. KENNELING YOUR PUPPY

For a permanent kennel your poodle should be able to stand up in his crate with his head up. 42 long by 31 high is generally a good size. However, as a puppy or for travel, you could go with the size 30 long by 25 high. If you do get a big crate, plan on using a divider of some type to make it smaller while crate training your pup.

3. TRANSITIONING YOUR PUPPY

One way to help your puppy adjust is to bring a t-shirt we can put in the whelping pen to smell like mom when they come home with you.

4. MICROCHIP

Information needed:

- Your name(s), number(s), & email(s)
- An alternate contact's name, number, & email (parents, children, good friend etc.)
- Your Vet's name, number, & email
- Bring \$25 (cash or check) for registration service

5. REGISTRATION

To complete the registration we need to receive:

- Name of Owner (a second owner can be listed for \$10 more)
- Address
- Email
- Phone number
- Name of Dog (up to 36 letters plus spaces allowed)
- If desired, you can use our kennel name "Spice Mountain's _____" or "Spice Mtn _____".

6. IDENTIFICATION WITH A TAG

It would be a great idea to already have a tag for your puppy's collar with your address and phone number all ready when you arrive to pick your puppy up.
